After 4 hours of presenting their city before 7 groups of engineers, and 4 individual special interest engineers, and a panel of judges for an additional presentation, plus a questioning and answering session, we were presented with

certificates for 3rd Place in State. In addition, we were presented an award from the Cuban-American Association of Civil Engineers, for the “Best Integration of Historical and Cultural Resources”.

The final awards were based on scores earned from the following: Their computer generated Future City, an essay on the science behind, and use of, Fuel Cell technology in their city, an abstract describing their city, their “to scale” model of their city (and the accuracy of said scale), the presentation of their cities to panels of judges, and the final presentations.
