What is the Science Club? The SSA+S Science Club was organized to provide opportunities for students to have fun and explore science. Our Science Club consists of members in all grade levels.

What do you do each month? Our focus during the first half of the year is helping students with their Science Fair projects. We meet every Thursday (September through November), from 4:30 -5:30 pm. Students should be a drink and snack with them, and a USB drive for any work they do on the computer, so they can save it and take it home to continue working on their project. We meet in the Renaissance Building, Mrs. Watson's room 29. Especially welcome are our returning Science Club members because they help as mentors and coaches on Science Fair projects.

Our weekly schedule changes to **every other Thursday, 4:30- 5:30 pm.** This year we are planning a **Desktop Catapult contest**. Students will learn a little about physics and motion using a staple remover as their catapult.
