Curriculum Topics: The state standards for this course align closely with the national standards for Theatre Education. The state standards focus on the following areas: Acting, Design, Playwriting, Connecting to history and culture, Analysis, and Life application. Please note that these topics are very broad in nature and are designed to give your student a well rounded foundation in the theatre arts. This class will also focus on cross curriculum units and encourages students to make connections between all areas both academic and artistic.

Course Requirements:

1. Students must participate in all class activities.
2. Students must participate in all scheduled rehearsals and performances. Limited rehearsals and performances outside of school hours will be **REQUIRED**. Notices of such rehearsal will be given at least two weeks in advance. *Term papers will be assigned in lieu of approved missed performances.* Only two missed rehearsals with **PRIOR** permission will be allowed per project. This **DOES NOT** include dress rehearsals and production week rehearsals.
3. Students will maintain a drama notebook and an in class journal. **THESE MUST BE KEPT IN THE DRAMA ROOM** and will be provided for the student.
4. Students will complete all assignments by the due date. **NO LATE WORK WILL BE ACCEPTED.** (Special circumstances may arise and work may be accepted after Ms. Borths has talked with a parent.) This includes memorization and in class presentation deadlines.
5. Students will put their name on all assignments or it will not be graded. **NO NAME = NO GRADE.**

Grading procedures:
