The Nomination Committee shall first review all the applicants and then refer any approved applicant with the committee's recommendations to the full Board for approval or denial.

Other Citizen:

The various community members and business representatives on the SAC Committee/ SSAS Board of Directors are a diverse group of members who were nominated by other members of the board, PTSS, and the School Employees. Any interested party shall submit nominations for the Board of Directors to the Nominating Committee. The Nomination Committee shall first review all the applicants and then refer any approved applicant with the committee's recommendations to the full Board for approval or denial.

Students:

There are no students on the SAC Committee/ SSAS Board of Directors.

Chairperson:

The chairperson of the committee is the principal of the school and the president of the board.
